The contracts, if awarded, shall be based on the NEC 3 suite of contracts as follows:

— An initial professional services contract for the development of the design sufficient to reach agreement on the Target (total of the prices) and a parallel ground investigation contract (NEC3 engineering and construction contract Option B) to provide information to inform the design and development of the Target, all of which is referred to as Phase 1.

— A detailed design and construction of the works contract (NEC3 engineering and construction contract Option C with amendments) referred to as Phase 2, which will be required to use the Target (as adjusted by index, if applicable), which was agreed during Phase 1. The Contracting Authority (also referred to as the Employer) shall issue a Notice to Proceed with this contract when the stated conditions precedent have been satisfied. Phase 1, if awarded, will contain a binding agreement (contract) to execute the contract for Phase 2 when the stated conditions precedent have all been satisfied.

The Economic Operator should note that the contract conditions may include a requirement to establish and utilise a Single Authority Project Bank Account (PBA) which will be administered by the Economic Operator and be used to make payments to first tier Sub-Contractors. The successful contractor's performance on the contract will be regularly monitored. If a contractor fails to reach satisfactory levels of contract performance they will be given a specified time to improve. If, after the specified time, they still fail to reach satisfactory levels of contract performance, the matter will be escalated to senior management in the Department for Regional Development for further action. If this occurs and their performance still does not improve to satisfactory levels within the specified period, it may be regarded as an act of grave professional misconduct and they may be issued with a Certificate of Unsatisfactory Performance and the contract may be terminated. The issue of a Certificate of Unsatisfactory

Performance will result in the contractor being excluded from all procurement competitions being undertaken by Centres of Procurement Expertise on behalf of bodies covered by the Northern Ireland Procurement Policy for a period of twelve months from the date of issue of the certificate.
