Initial appointments will involve an assessment of the person's needs using the Outcome Star tool and/or Warwick and Edinburgh scale, as well as a comprehensive risk assessment. Pro-active promotion and engagement and will ensure that the service is reaching the community where the need is greatest. Service delivery from appropriately qualified staff with the relevant skills and experience and, where appropriate, people with lived experience of mental health problems in either an employment or voluntary arrangement.
