II.1.5. Short description of the contract or purchase(s)

For more than 30 years the a/c tractors Bucher and Douglas have been in daily use. They have already exceeded the end of their planned service life. Due to the difficult procurement of spare parts, maintenance is time-consuming and very expensive.

With the implementation of a uniform tractor concept and the elimination of outdated a/c tractors (e.g. Bucher, Douglas or manual tractors) the short- and long-time preservation of sufficient a/c tractor capacities is ensured, and by means of a uniform fleet policy costs are reduced.

Primary use The a/c tractors 25t el to be procured are used for the displacement of all aircraft operated by the air force on military airbases and auxiliary airbases from shelter to shelter or from location to location, and for the placement into and removal from shelters and halls.

The commercial a/c tractor 25t el with a hauled load of up to 25 000 kg is used for a slope of 5 %. The a/c tractor 25t el is equipped according to the ordinance on technical requirements to be met by road vehicles (VTS) and admitted for road traffic with form 13.20A and consists of:

— Basic unit with electric motor,— Cabin with lateral sliding doors left and right,— Trailer coupling back and front for NATO lug,— Battery charger,— Central water replenishing system,— Documentation / training documents,— Introductory and training courses

Secondary use With the a/c tractor 25t el the maneuvering and positioning of a/c, with minimum space available, must be possible on civilian and military airbases in Switzerland and abroad.

Equally it must be possible to tow the trailers and power units (GSE) used in air traffic.

The complete suitability criteria listed below, without any restriction or modification, must be signed and enclosed with the request for participation, otherwise the request is not considered. The number of participating tenderers invited to submit a tender is limited to 4. The resulting ranking of tenderers based on the assessable suitability criteria is taken into consideration. All tenderers with an equal number of points as the tenderer ranked fourth are also taken into consideration.

Suitability criteria with unique character:

E1: Enforced payment collection and commercial register records or equivalent foreign document (not older than 3 months, the day of submission is decisive).

E2: Company portrait with organisation chart, legal form, number of employed personnel and turnover.

E3: Evidence provided by tenderer that he will assume the responsibility for the entire business, in particular that tenderer is the sole contracting partner of the awarding authority. Possible involved partners have to be contracted by tenderer.

E4: Evidence of ability to deliver for the assessment period December 2012 to April 2013. From KW 50/12 ONE sample vehicle, exactly meeting the technical specification, must be available to armasuisse on the Alpnach airbase.

E5: The tendering supplier owns or provides his own service organisation.

E6: The tendering supplier guarantees fleet support and service (incl. spare part management and maintenance in Switzerland) of the entire procurement volume during the entire service life of at least 15 years.

E7: The tendering supplier guarantees a reaction time of <24h for spare parts as well as service and repair work.

E8: Tenderer confirms that the regular training of his own maintenance personnel (service technicians) in Switzerland is guaranteed.

E9: Evidence of a single point of contact in Switzerland for all administrative business processes such as orders, payments, quality management, etc.

Assessable suitability criteria:

E10: Tenderer must provide verifiable references for the manufacture and supply of "electrically operated aircraft tractors": A reference is considered comparable if.

—comparable manufacture and supply of aircraft tractors electric or similar with at least 25t hauled load in the past five years.

E11: Tenderer guarantees a maximum reaction time of X after notification. As evidence reference lists of services for at least 5 customers during the last 12 months are to be enclosed.

E12: Tenderer guarantees fault correction / MTTR (Mean time to repair) within the following time or the supply of an adequate replacement. As evidence reference lists of fault corrections for at least 5 customers during the last 12 months are to be enclosed.

E13: Tenderer guarantees the supply of spare parts during X years after delivery of the vehicles. Evidence of units which can be supplied with spare parts, excl. expendable parts for service and maintenance work. Supplied material components and the age of the units must be evident.

E14: Tenderer confirms that he provides a guarantee of X months at no cost for the vehicles (excl. battery). The stated value is to be listed /referenced.

E15: Tenderer confirms that he provides a guarantee of X months at no cost for the battery (excl. vehicles). The stated value is to be listed/referenced.

E16: Tenderer operates his own development and construction department in the domain of electrically operated aircraft tractors.

E17: Tenderer/manufacturer is certified with a quality management system. A copy of the certificate or application is to be enclosed.

E18: Tenderer/manufacturer is certified with an environmental management system. A copy of the certificate or application is to be enclosed.

E19: Supplier disposes of the delivery capacity listed below. The evidence is to be confirmed in writing.

E20: Tenderer confirms the acceptance of the enclosed procurement contract. Confirmation on separate A4 sheet with signature. All deviations are to be identified and justified.
