JCB Sales Ltd are the Design Authority for the equipment and if not placed with them the lack of safety integrity would lead to JCB Ltd ceasing to underwrite the safety of the vehicles. Without access to the IPR, technical data and knowledge the equipment capability would be severely disrupted and could not be use. A different supplier would mean new testing, new verification and validation to ensure that the safety and suitability for the service of the systems and their interoperability with both the systems and the platforms is not compromised.
