II.1.4. Short description

In December 2019, NORAD and IDA signed a Grant Agreement regarding the project "Making DPOs equal partners of inclusive Development in Africa" (reference n.: RAF-19/0046, hereinafter "the Grant", "the Project", or "the Agreement"). The Project aimed to increase the

influence of the disability rights movement to shape the development agenda in Sub-Saharan Africa towards the full and effective realization of human rights of persons with disabilities, thus leading the target group, i.e., persons with disabilities, including from underrepresented groups, to enjoy equal human rights and full participation in society.

The Project is currently in its final year of implementation. The overall purpose of the evaluation is to examine the results achieved as agreed by IDA and NORAD, the processes of change induced by the project, and generate learning on what works to advance the rights of persons with disabilities, including underrepresented groups, in Sub-Saharan Africa.
