The provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (APA) on legal holidays do not apply in accordance with Article 56 paragraph 2 of the PPA.

It will be forwarded by the latter to the "Ramp Management Guisanplatz 1". •The submission must be made by 15.00 hours at the latest on the submission date mentioned under item 1.4 against issuance of a receipt confirmation of the ramp management. •Opening hours of the ramp management: Mo - Fr 07.00 - 12.00 h / 13.00 - 15.00 h (outside these hours no offer can be made). b) For submission by post: The postmark or barcode receipt of the shipping service provider shall be authoritative (company frankings shall not be deemed postmarks). c) For delivery to a diplomatic or consular representation of Switzerland: The acknowledgement of receipt from the relevant representative shall be decisive. The acknowledgement of receipt must be sent to the e-mail address specified in section 1.2 by the latest by the deadline for submission of the offer, stating the project in question.
