The consumables were previously bought from a national framework under Lot 4 of the tender which was awarded for Haemodialysis Machines, Machine Maintenance and machine specific consumables (consumable to be purchased from national framework). This national framework has since expired. The contract is for the supply of Haemodialysis consumables from Fresenius Medical Care for a period of 2 years with the option to extend for a further 12+12 months.
