In some cases it may be necessary to engineer design technical solutions, and in such circumstances the contractor shall procure an engineering design consultant with sufficient competence and responsibility classification in relation to the assignments.

Bybanen AS wants to enter into a framework agreement with one construction machine contractor for the delivery of contractor services with crew, construction management as well as machines, transport and equipment for works that shall be carried out at our facilities connected to the Light Rail and trolleybuses.

In general, the contractor shall be able to take care of the maintenance work and projects through the framework agreement.

The contractor must be able to procure all of the necessary requirement for all relevant assignments. This also concerns necessary safety and sign age material. The contractor must also provide the preparation of the sign plan and roadwork signs.

The contractor procures materials. The mark-up shall be 10 %. In certain circumstances the material for the projects can be procured by the Contracting Authority. This will be agreed from assignment to assignment.
