Explanation:

A situation of extreme urgency exists both in the UK and across the world, in the context of the Covid-19 pandemic. Lopinavir/ritonavir tablets, one of the drugs of choice worldwide for the treatment of Covid-19 is scarce in supply and the contracting authority having identified a supplier that was ready willing and able to supply lopinavir/ritonavir tablets needed to move quickly to secure this supply. Failure to do this would have resulted in lopinavir/ritonavir tablets being sold by the supplier to another country due to the high demand globally. As such and at this time, the timelines for the open procedure, restricted procedure (even where accelerated) and the competitive procedure with negotiation could not be complied with in order for DHSC is to secure this supply of lopinavir/ritonavir tablets.
