The Authority may, at its discretion offer the successful bidder the opportunity to undertake maintenance and repair of some or all of the existing and new CCTV equipment within the Authorities estate. The Authority may also, throughout the 5-year term offer any new supply and installation requirements to the successful bidder. Any new equipment provided by and installed by the successful bidder may also be subject to maintenance agreement up to 5 years from the initial installation date. At the end of any new initial term the Authority may extend the term for a further 3-years.
