II.2. Scope of the procurement

II.2.1. Total quantity or scope

Shropshire County PCT wishes to commission a fully integrated prison based Drug and Alcohol Treatment Service for HMP Shrewsbury and HMPO \ YOI Stoke Heath. The service will be provided within the prisons and will replace the previously distinct prison based substance misuse programmes which included IDTS, CARAT's COVAID, PASRO and CBDT. The service will provide comprehensive interventions to address drug and alcohol misuse at all levels from information and advice to interventions for severe dependency. It is anticipated that the service will work with in the region of 1 000 individuals across this spectrum in any one year, with approximately 10 % of these on clinical management at any one time. Services will include both pharmacological and psychosocial interventions to address problematic drug and/or alcohol use to support recovery. Services will also include the management of 2 x 24 hour dedicated inpatient beds, the provision of first night prescribing, 24 hours administration and dispensation of medications associated with substance misuse treatment and any associated out of hours medical/ nursing cover necessary to discharge these service requirements. A small number of Prison staff will form part of the service delivery model and will be available to the provider to support service delivery.

The key objective of the Service is to reduce the use of illicit drugs, prescribed and over the counter medication and/or alcohol by Service Users, lessening the risk of HIV, Hepatitis B and C, and other blood borne infections and the risk of drug related death by:

- delivering a service that is accessible to all, responsive to service users' needs and that seeks to proactively engage them and provoke positive and sustainable change through the delivery of appropriate and evidence based interventions,
- developing a recovery focused treatment system which maximises positive outcomes for all service users,
- working with, and responding to, the holistic needs of the service user by working with other providers within the establishment and by reaching out into the local community to deliver a coordinated package of care,
- demonstrating appropriate activity towards agreed outcomes evidenced by the collection and analysis of relevant data.

This will include completion of records in line with the National Drug Treatment Monitoring

System (NDTMS);

— encouraging and supporting Service Users to be an active participant in their own treatment journey, for example through supporting the development of peer support models of care and family focused interventions.

The successful Provider must work within national and local guidelines and provide standardised referral, assessment and treatment. The services will be available to all prisoners within HMP Shrewsbury and HMP/YOI Stoke Heath.

The principal outcomes for the Service will be based upon The Patel Report and include:-

— reduced drug and alcohol,

— reduced risk of re-offending,

— improved health, social functioning and relationships - through the use of recovery tools that can evidence demonstrable and sustained positive behavioural change.
