The contract includes installation and migration of the configuration to a complete functioning system including an administration tool. The system shall be operated by a SSB's own ICT section. The delivery shall include:

- All necessary software;
- All the necessary hardware (access points and administration tool);
- Complete installation including full configuration and integration with existing network systems;
- Documentation;

- Training in the form of courses for operational personnel;
- Service and maintenance contract;
- Assistance on an hourly basis;
- Engineering design, design, installation, configuration, migration, testing, training and documentation.
