Open tender contest in accordance with parts I and II for the procurement of securing and further delivery of hazardous waste.

II.1.5. Short description of the contract or purchase(s)

The aim of the assignment is to risk assess, identify and, in a safe way, transport and deliver approx. 160 tons of hazardous waste to a certified site. The assignment includes the costs of delivering the waste to a certified site. A certified site can be both a reception and temporary storage for hazardous waste and a treatment plant for hazardous waste with a licence in accordance with the Pollution Act.

The hazardous waste was collected from local industry companies and consists of, amongst other things, waste containing oil, paint, solvents, batteries etc. The waste owner has an estimated total amount of 160 tons of hazardous waste, but the amount is very uncertain. Further details of the containers and the hazardous waste is in annex 1 of the tender documentation. The amount and content of the hazardous waste has not been fully mapped and a part of the assignment will be to identify the waste.

The waste is stored in five containers at Flatholmen and five containers at Vegsund in Ålesund municipality. See annex 1 of the tender documentation for further details of the localities.

The County Governor shall, as the pollution authority, initiate the clearance of the hazardous waste, as the responsible owner has not done this after an imposition to clear up. The aim of the assignment is to get all the hazardous waste delivered to a certified site in a safe way.

The contract is for the safe and responsible handling of hazardous waste from a previous reception and temporary storage site for hazardous waste in Ålesund, including risk assessment, identification and the transport of approx. 160 tons hazardous waste to a certified site. The assignment comprises the following:

- Risk assess the assignment;
- Initiate risk reducing measures before the work of removing the hazardous waste starts;
- Identifying the hazardous waste;
- Re-wrapping and marking of the waste if this has not already been properly done;
- Transport the waste in a safe and legal way to a certified site;
- Ensure that the waste is delivered to a site that is certified to receive the correct types of

hazardous waste;

— Handle potential acute emissions during the process;

— Report to the County Governor if the waste is spilt onto the ground;

— Report to the County Governor if previous leaks from containers into the ground are discovered.

The assignment shall be started immediately and carried out as quickly as possible. The waste in the 5 containers at Flatholmen shall be prioritised and cleared first. The assignment will be seen as completed when all the waste and all the 10 containers are removed from the areas, and all the hazardous waste has been received by a certified site.
