NHS England, Health in the Justice System (London) wishes to commission integrated providers of Prison Health Care Services for three London prisons; HMP Wandsworth (Lot 1), HMP Pentonville (Lot 2) and HMP Brixton (Lot 3). It is anticipated that the Prison Health Care Services for each site will include but not be limited to:

The establishments listed require the following services to be delivered:

1. Primary Care GP and Nursing Services;
2. Healthcare Administration;
3. Mental Health Services;
4. Sexual Health Services;
5. Clinical Substance Misuse Services;
6. Allied Healthcare Services (e.g. Chiroprody/Podiatry, Physiotherapy etc.);

11. Escorts and Bedwatches management;
12. Radiology Services (including radiographers, radiology and radiation protection advisor/s).

The Contracting Authority wishes to receive responses to the PQQ from suitably qualified healthcare providers experienced in healthcare service provision within secure settings ("Bidders") with the necessary capacity and capability (or a demonstrable ability to provide the necessary capacity and capability) to provide the specified services within the requisite timescales.

The Contracting Authority intends to award one contract as a result of this procurement process for each of the Prisons (Lots 1 to 3 above).
