Phase 1: involves wall tiling, floor tiling, new suspended ceiling, new cubicles and vanity units, renewal of shower and WC area (Inc. new ambulant toilet). As well as associated mechanical and electrical fittings and connection works;

Phase 2: involves wall tiling, floor tiling, new suspended ceiling, new vanity units and mosaic work to the changing and spa facilities. Complemented by the installation of advance monsoon shower facility, Alder salt sauna featured with salt block wall and an overhaul of the plantroom to ensure adequate water and power supply. As well as associated mechanical and electrical fittings and connection works.

The estimated value of this contract is 500 000 GBP and it is envisaged that it will start in June 2019 for a duration of 12 months.
