The International Disability Alliance (IDA) was established in 1999 as a network of global and, since 2007, regional organizations of persons with disabilities (OPDs) and their families. As a core funder of IDA, the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (Sida) is commissioning an evaluation of core activities of IDA over the past three years. Sida has

supported IDA since 1999 and with core support since 2010. Sida currently supports IDA through support for the implementation of IDA's strategic framework 2020-2023.

Considering the rapid development of IDA since Sida's initial support in 2010, and the new strategy which will be constructed during 2023, an external evaluation of IDA's core activities from 1 January 2020 until 31 March 2023 will enable taking stock of what has been achieved by IDA during this time period and will provide useful evidence of where the organization stands today.
