- Blasting of the rock caverns, scaling of rock surfaces, the securing of rock(s) and the transport of the blasted rock / soil.

The Awarding Authority IVAR IKS has access to a private landfill which is approx. 600 meters from the new rock cavern. If the contractor itself will have jurisdiction over the blasted rock to a landfill site which can be considered by the Awarding Authority, a requirement for consideration is that the landfill is approved by the county and the municipality.

If the landfill is not approved by the county Governor / the municipality then the contractor must apply as soon as possible.
