This contest is for the collection, transport, and processing of waste from households and holiday cabins in Sarpsborg Municipality. In addition municipal business waste must be collected, and waste from other business customers that the municipality believes it is appropriate to collect together with the household waste.

The contest is for a framework agreement for the provision of waste collection services for Sarpsborg Municipality. The service includes the collection, transport, and processing of residual waste, food waste, paper/cardboard, plastic packaging, glass and metal packaging from households and holiday cabins in Sarpsborg Municipality. In addition municipal business waste is to be collected.

The service also includes processing waste from the collected fractions.

The stated volumes are an estimate and are not binding for the contracting authority. The scope will depend on the contracting authority's budget situation, activities, and other framework factors. The contracting authority is not bound to the volume in the contract period. See the procurement documents for further information.

III.1.2. Economic and financial standing

List and brief description of selection criteria:

Requirements connected to the tenderer's economic and financial position:

Economic capacity is required to implement this contract (ESPD: Part 4 B.56.3). Tenderers must have the economic and financial capacity that secures fulfilment of the contract, including a minimum credit rating of A and a credit limit of minimum NOK 0.5 million. If a tenderer does not have a satisfactory credit rating, economic capacity can be alternatively documented in another way that the contracting authority deems appropriate.

Documentation requirement:

Credit rating A (credit worthy) carried out by a publicly certified credit rating institution. If a tenderer does not fulfil the above-mentioned documentation requirement, other documentation that the contracting authority finds suitable for documenting economic and financial capacity can be accepted, such as a parent company guarantee or another guarantee/security. The contracting authority reserves the right to obtain supplementary information about the tenderer's finances.

Any support from other companies for compliance with the qualification requirement.

If a tenderer is dependent on other companies to meet this qualification requirement, an explanation thereof must be given below. The contracting authority retains the right to collect supplementary information, bank guarantees or similar.

Documentation requirement:

The contracting authority reserves the right to obtain supplementary information about the tenderer's finances.

List and brief description of selection criteria:

Tenderers, possibly with support from sub-supplier(s), must have good experience from comparable or equivalent assignments/deliveries (ESPD: Part IV B.58-4).

Documentation requirement:

An account of relevant assignments in the last 3 years. The account shall include a description of the assignment, contracting authority, value, date, name and contact data of a contact person.

Tenderers must have a satisfactory quality assurance system (ESPD: Part IV B.58-4).

Documentation requirement:

Certificate of the company's quality system/management system issued by independent bodies, which confirms that the tenderer complies with certain quality assurance standards, for example ISO certification. The contracting authority will also accept other documentation demonstrating that the tenderer has equivalent quality assurance measures.

Tenderers must have satisfactory procedures in place to carry out the assignment in an environmentally responsible manner (ESPD: Part IV B.58-4).

Documentation requirement: Tenderers shall enclose documentation ensuring that the assignment will be carried out in an environmentally responsible manner. This can be documented by a report of existing routines or a valid certificate from a third party verified system (for example Eco-lighthouse, ISO 14001, EMAS), copy of the table of contents in the tenderer's environmental management system, description of the system or with other relevant documentation.
