The contract value specified at section II.2.1, reflects the estimated value of the original contract subject to this Contract Notice, plus the estimated value of a repetition contract taking into consideration the maximum period of time for which the authority may in its absolute discretion award a repetition contract.

For the avoidance of doubt, any contract for the repetition of these works is not guaranteed. Should the authority pursue a contract for the repetition of these works it may choose to award a contract for any period between 12 months and 3 years. Therefore, the maximum possible length of time for which the works may be required is 6 years, broken down as follows: 3 years (original contract); plus 1-3 years (repetition of the original contract). The contract value specified at section II.2.1, reflects the estimated value of a 6 year overall contract period.
