The objective is to map, analyse and find effects of whether the new general access to temporary employment gives increased access to ordinary working life for groups with a weak connection to working life.

The project shall map, analyse and find effects of whether the new general access to temporary employment gives increased access to ordinary working life for groups with a weak

connection to working life. The project shall look at the effects for immigrants. In addition other groups that have problems with getting a foothold in working life can be looked at.
