The Contracting Authority expects to increase the volume to more than 10 000 units during the agreement period. This applies in particular to i.a. increased use of tablets in schools. Due to the expected life span of 3-5 years for this equipment, the Contracting Authority expects the annual procurement to be between 1 000 and 1 500 units. This estimate is not binding for the Contracting Authority.
