Tenderers are advised that in order to give as much flexibility as possible on purchase options in relation to current and future funding allocations the College is also seeking staged installation options, especially for options including the provision and installation of a new 3T MRI System.

The College also reserves the right to purchase only one new/upgraded/traded-in MRI system. Tenderers may submit tenders for one or multiple procurement delivery options, including variant bids.

Tenderers may also submit one or multiple pricing options for the same procurement delivery option.

Tenderers are also asked to include the option of decommissioning and removing existing equipment.

Tenderers are advised that the College is seeking a full turnkey solution for the delivery of this procurement which shall include all works necessary to facilitate where necessary the removal and installation of Equipment. The Works will include the installation, modification, adaptation and/or renewal of related existing infrastructure and equipment.

The College is also seeking a commitment to enter into a very close collaborative partnership for the purpose of clinical research.
