Upgrading and supplementing of floodlit track lighting along the Holmenkollen rollerski track.

II.1.5. Short description of the contract or purchase(s)

Oslo kommune c/o the Undertaking for Culture and Sports Facilities (KID), hereafter referred to as the contracting authority, hereby invites tenderers to an open tender competition in connection with the procurement of upgrading and supplementing of floodlit track lighting along the Holmenkollen rollerski track. The objective of the procurement is to ensure safe conditions for use of the existing track structure in all seasons, and a better adaptation of the level over the year. The procurement comprises both services and goods, but the goods procurement is expected to have the largest scope. The primary part of the procurement consists of 1-1 replacement of 103 fixtures on interior floodlit tracks that are asphalted and used as rollerski tracks in the summer season. This work is expected to be completed quickly after signing of the contract. The tenderer should provide a binding schedule for this work in the tender offer. By the time the contract is signed there will be working drawings that described exact placement. The contract will also include 5 options, that comprise new establishment of track lighting at different locations in the track network. All options include the delivery of poles with foundation, cables and all electrical works. All excavation works are included in other agreements.

II.2.1. Total quantity or scope

The delivery will be a stand-alone procurement concerning equipment and electrical contractor, but has options for the release of further works. The primary assignment concerns replacement of the lighting fixtures on interior floodlit tracks in the Holmenkollen national facility. The primary part of the procurement consists of 1-1 replacement of 103 fixtures on interior floodlit tracks that are asphalted and used as rollerski tracks in the summer season. The work include i.a. dismantling and removal of the existing fixtures, as well as delivery, assembling and connecting on the same poles. The delivery also includes delivery and implementation of control automation to compliment the existing lighting switchboard cabinets for a complete system. For further information see annex 2 of the tender documentation. In their schedule, the tenderer should account for how it is envisaged performed. The assignment consists of a further five options where the timing of any release will either be parallel to the start up in autumn 2016 or quarter 2/3 in 2017.
