- give a complete overview of Norwegian participation in various projects through the project bank;
- distribute links to relevant information sources in Norway and the EU.

As a starting point, the contract has an upper financial limit of NOK 450 000 a year, with the exception of 2021 when the limit is set to NOK 300 000. The contract will be valid from 1 August 2021 until 31 December 2025, i.e., 5 months and 4 years. The contract value is, thus, estimated to be NOK 2 100 000, excluding VAT in total.
