These plans must comply with the sampling rules in Annex IV of the directive. This directive also establishes the frequencies and level of sampling and the groups of substances to be controlled for each food commodity. The NFSA controls through targeted sampling the levels of certain organochlorines, pyrethroids, carbamates, organophosphates, heavy metals, mycotoxins, dyes, veterinary drugs and banned substances in live animals and animal products. Samples content above the Maximum Residue Limit (MRL), or finding of a prohibited substance, would be submitted for further action according to investigations of the NFSA.
