Corby Borough Council requires an experienced supplier to provide and install a range of cardio-vascular, fixed resistance machines, multi-stations and free weights into the gym at Corby East Midlands International Pool.

The proposed development is scheduled to take place between Monday, 12.12.2016 and Thursday, 5.1.2017. The gym will open to the public on Friday, 6.1.2016.

Corby Borough Council is seeking a supplier to provide and install new fitness equipment (70 stations) as specified and an appropriate service package, at Corby East Midlands International Pool, to renew and update the existing provision.

The installation must take place as specified between 12.12.016 and 5.1.2017 as the gym will re-open to the public on 6th January. Training to Council staff on the equipment must also be provided during this period.

The supplier must also maintain the equipment for a period of up to 5 years following installation.

The Council will be responsible for removing and disposing the old fitness equipment.

Corby Borough Council will incorporate a minimum 10 day standstill period at the point of notification of the decision to award the contracts. The decision notice will incorporate the award criteria, the reasons for the decision, the reasons (if any) why a tenderer did not meet any specification, the identity of the successful tenderer(s) and a precise statement of when the standstill period is expected to end. Any appeal or challenge against the award decision must be communicated to the address stated in section I.1) above within the standstill period.
