Justification for direct award: The contract can be provided only by a particular economic operator because of an absence of competition for technical reasons

Other justification: The contract is awarded without prior publication of a contract notice in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 32(2)(b)(ii) of Directive 2014/24/EU, i.e. competition is absent for technical reasons. The procurement concerns a pulmonary function testing system intended for use in a hospital environment, where there is a requirement for full integration within an existing clinical and digital infrastructure. The system must provide a single, unified software environment supporting standardised testing protocols, harmonised reporting, and seamless interoperability with existing hospital information systems, including electronic health records. In addition, the system must ensure continuity and comparability of clinical measurements over time, which necessitates compatibility with established workflows, data structures, and historical datasets currently in use within the contracting authority. The required solution must also include specific technical functionalities, including integrated ultrasonic measurement technology, automated environmental compensation, and features that minimise calibration requirements and reduce operational variability, thereby supporting consistent and reproducible clinical outcomes. Following a prior market assessment, it has been established that only one economic operator, Fastus ehf on behalf of Jaeger Medical, is capable of delivering a solution that meets all of the above technical and interoperability requirements without the need for substantial modifications, additional integration layers, or disruption to existing clinical workflows. Furthermore, interchangeability with alternative systems would result in disproportionate technical difficulties, including challenges related to system integration, data comparability, and continuity of clinical practice. The absence of competition is therefore due to objective technical reasons, and not the result of an artificial narrowing of the parameters of the procurement.
