Oddernes tunnel and the Banehei tunnel are located on the E18 in Kristiansand kommune. Average annual daily traffic for both of the tunnels is 50 000. The tunnels shall be upgraded in accordance with the Tunnel Safety Regulations. In this connection, some rehabilitation of the tunnels shall also be carried out. Most of the work is described as turnkey contract, but there are also some quantity regulated items for work notifications, permanent signs, VF insurance and securing of rock support.

- Denser (closer) with emergency telephones in ramps at Baneheia;
- Some rock support in the Banehei tunnel;
- Replacement to fire-resistant joints between wall elements;
- Supplementing of PE foam and fire protection;
- Fire resistant divers in surface-water manholes;
- Replacement of storm water pipes, manhole frames and covers in the Banehei tunnel;
- Moving of 3 fire hydrants;
- Upgrading of fans to 50 MW fire;
- Suspension bridges and light fixtures will be replaced;
- New redundant supply of all emergency equipment;
- New guiding lights every 25 m, mounted on the correct side;
- New digital video cameras;
- Replace cables with fire resistant cables;
- Replacement and setting up of new signs.
