Description: The contracting authority would like to use this procurement to enter into a framework agreement with one tenderer. The aim of the contract is to cover the contracting authority's need for transport and treatment of hazardous building waste, from Attvin to final treatment at a certified treatment facility, in accordance with the requirement specifications. The aim is also to ensure that hazardous waste is taken care of in such a way that it does not create pollution or damage to humans or animals, or danger to it, and to contribute to an appropriate and reliable system for handling hazardous waste, cf. The Waste Regulations chapter 11. The contract is for: Waste with phthalates (e.g. floor coverings), waste that contains bronched flame retardants, waste containing chlorinated paraffins and for the options waste that includes PUR foam insulation and pressure impregnated and creosoted wood. Comments on the contract: Responsibility for the waste is to be taken over by a tenderer when the waste is charged in the tenderer's vehicles. The procurement is for the treatment of various types of hazardous building waste and building waste that cannot be handled together with normal household and commercial waste due to chemical, physical and/or biological qualities. Waste types included in this agreement are in accordance with the price form.

Everything that is collected as hazardous waste shall be treated at a certified treatment facility. Emphasis is put on the fact that the hazardous waste in accordance with this agreement shall be directly to the final treatment facility and not the reception facility. Tenderers shall, thus, offer final treatment of the hazardous waste at one/several treatment facilities in accordance with requirements. Fractions other than what is stated may be included in this agreement. The volume of NOK shall not, nevertheless, exceed the maximum amount set for the contract. New waste types in the contract period: If new waste types are added in the contract period, it shall be possible for the customer to enter into this agreement if they do not make up a significant part of the contract. In such cases the same price calculations shall be used for new waste types as for other waste types in this contract. The contracting authority reserves the right, however, to hold a new competition for new waste types during the contract period. Description of selection criterion: Credit rating Requirements: Tenderers must have the financial capacity to execute the contract. The tenderer is required to be credit worthy, minimum A, in accordance with Dun & Bradstreet's service riskguardian suite (<https://riskguardian.bisnode.no>), or have the financial capacity to execute the contract based on the contracting authority's discretion. Documentation requirement: The Contracting Authority will carry out their own assessment of the supplier's finances through RiskGuardian Suite. Tenderers can enclose other necessary information if they believe that RiskGuardian Suite does not provide a correct picture of the financial situation. The RiskGuardian Suite service includes all Nordic countries. As a general rule, the Contracting Authority will not accept credit ratings from other company and accounting information systems than RiskGuardian Suite due to equal treatment of the tenderers. Description of selection criterion: Experience Requirements: The tenderer, or employees at the tenderer are required to have experience from at least two equivalent assignments during the last three years. Equivalent assignments mean a contract for the transport and treatment of hazardous building waste. Documentation requirement: Complete the annex "The Tenderer's experience" or other document with equivalent information. If another document is used, the response shall be maximum 1 A4 page. The response shall not include a cover page or table of contents. Any pages after page 1 will not be considered. Any links etc. in the reply will not be considered.

Name: Price

Description: Weighting: The award criteria is weighted 70%. The award criteria consists of three (3) sub-criteria: The sub-criteria Avfall from the price form will be weighted 70% of this award criteria. The sub-criteria Option 1: Impregnated pressure and creosote treated wood from the price form is weighted 25% of this award criteria. The sub-criteria Option 2: IFraction: PUR foam insulation from the price form is weighted 5% of this award criteria. Orientation: Tenderers shall fill in the attached price form in their cost calculations and submit as an annex to the tender in Excel format. All fields in the attached price form marked with yellow shall be completed. Missing the price fields can cause difficulties in assessing the tender and the tender can then be rejected. We have requested prices in accordance with volume, regardless of the size of the waste, as this can vary based on the waste management. The volume is not subject to collection, this can lead to rejection. All prices are excluding VAT, including all direct or indirect expenses and duties that could be incurred in connection with the delivery. Order fees and invoice fees are to be seen as expenses. The prices shall include all costs for the Customer who is included in this competition. Costs that the tenderer knows will be incurred, but that are not specifically stated in the tender, will be seen as included in the stated costs. Journeys: All travel expenses shall be included in the offered prices. Costs for the execution of the assignment, including, but not limited to, parts and materials/equipment that the tenderer shall provide, consumables, general costs (including administration and work management) central to the assignment, taxes, fees and profits, shall be included in the offered prices. Costs for post-sorting etc. shall be included in the unit prices. I.e. tenderers must include all foreseeable costs when completing the price form, even if not all cost elements and services are described in detail in the tender documentation. Scores achieved on each of the sub-criteria will be multiplied by interrelated weighting and added together. The tenderer's total points for this award criteria is weighted with the award criteria's weighting percentage.

Name: Environment

Description: Weighting: The award criteria is weighted 30%. The award criteria consists of 2 sub-criteria: The sub-criterion "Treatment methods" is weighted 70% of this award criteria. The sub-criterion "Miljøtiltak" will be weighted 30% of this award criteria. Orientation: The sub-criteria Processing methods: The contracting authority would like the processing method for hazardous building waste to be as high as possible in the waste pyramid/hierarchy and that the treatment method shall occur as far as possible in accordance with the following order of priority: 1. Goes to material recovery 2. Goes to burning with energy utilisation 3. Goes to burning without energy utilisation 4. Goes to the deposit Tenderers are requested to fill in green cells in the "Form award criterion environment". Tenderers are requested to fill in a percentage distribution for the different treatment methods per waste type for the selected waste types. The responses shall be unequivocal. Documentation of the figures that are filled in the form "Skjema tildelingskriteriet miljø" must be able to be sent on request (both for evaluation and throughout the contract period). Orientation: The sub-criterion Environmental measures: The contracting authority would like tenderers to use treatment systems that give the best possible benefit and as many as possible strain on the environment. 1. Tenderers shall describe their role as driving the utilisation of new technological, strategic and operational systems in the waste pyramid/hierarchy. 2. Tenderers shall be able to track the waste right up until the final treatment. Describe solution for traceability. Both of the points shall be answered in a Word or PDF document and the responses shall be at maximum 1 A4 page. Any links to websites or similar in the reply will not be evaluated. Evaluation: The sub-criteria Processing methods: This sub-criteria will be assessed based on the tenderer's responses in green cells in the respective "Form for the award criteria environment". Treatment methods will be given points (p.) as follows: Material recovery 10 p. Burning with energy recovery 7 p. Burning without energy recovery 5 p. Landfill 0 p. The above points are given that 100% of the waste type is treated by the method in question. If less than 100% of the waste type is treated by the method in question, or it is treated with a combination of different methods, the score will be calculated based on the stated percentage distribution. Example: recycling materials 50% and burning with energy recovery 50% gives 8.5 p. for this type of waste. If there is a lack of responses for all or parts of a waste type, 0 p. will be given for the entire or portion for which there has not been an answer. Ambiguous responses can also lead to a reduction in points. A score is thus calculated from 0 to 10 for each of the selected waste types, based on the tenderer's response. This achieved score per waste type is multiplied by the estimated volume per annum for the waste type in question. Then these sums for all the waste in question are summed together to a total sum. Best solution (the tenderer with the highest total sum) will be awarded the highest score (10). Other solutions will be awarded a point score relative to the best solution. Evaluation: The sub-criterion Environmental measures: When evaluating this sub-criteria, a procurement assessment will be made of the tenderer's response, where the best solution is awarded the highest score (10) and other solutions will be awarded a point score proportionally based on the best solution. Evaluation of the award criteria Environment: This award criteria will be assessed based on the tenderer's description of the award criteria. A procurement assessment will be made when evaluating the described system. For each sub-criteria, the best system will be given the highest score (10) and other solutions will be awarded a point score relative to the best solution. Scores achieved on each of the sub-criteria will be multiplied by interrelated weighting and added together. The tenderer's total points for this award criteria is weighted with the award criteria's weighting percentage.
