The aim of the procurement is to cover our need for the following: - Audio engineering - Lighting engineering - Stage equipment - AV-technics- Presentation and video playing - Personnel for set up/rigging of equipment Arrangements will be held in different places in the country. Some gatherings will be carried out in our own premises where the technical framework is in place, but where we can, however, need personnel or equipment supplements. In other cases the events will be held in external premises, e.g. hotel/conference/course premises, where in some cases there will be a need for full delivery of sound, lighting technique and personnel. This will depend on the chosen location and which facilities are available for the contracting authority.
