Documentation requirements: Tenderers shall not enclose documentation. The contracting authority will obtain credit rating/financial data itself. If a tenderer is not subject to credit appraisal, or if a tenderer wishes to document that the credit rating gives a misleading picture of the economic situation, the economic and financial position can be substantiated with other appropriate documentation.
