The contracting authority aims at limiting the number of mini competitions to one (1) per annum, but there may be a need for several. Call-offs will be made if needed. Mini competitions are used as a main rule for call-offs where the total list price exceeds NOK 200,000 excluding VAT, but the Contracting Authority reserves the right to use mini-competitions for minor procurements as well. In case of individual call-offs that do not trigger mini competitions, call-offs will be awarded to the tenderer who is ranked as no. 1 in the framework agreement's award.
