The system must have proven ability to provide functionality to promote standardisation in build and maintenance of paediatric chemotherapy clinical trials /protocols within south-west cancer network. The impetus for this project is the need to be compliant with recognised standards (to prescribe chemotherapy electronically) by September 2017 or risk penalisation for non-compliance. There may be future requirement for Adults Chemotherapy Prescribing System to allow synergies and efficiencies between the Adults and Paediatric Chemotherapy units bidders are to include future optional modules in System Pricing matrix.
