II.1.4. Short description

St Vincent's Housing Association (SVHA) is a charitable registered provider, founded in 1971 by the lay Catholic St Vincent's de Paul Society. It has circa 3 500 homes in 18 local authority

areas with significant number of homes in Rochdale, Manchester, Bolton, Salford, Pendle, Ribble Valley and Hyndburn. SVHA is seeking bids from service providers to provide a concierge and guarding service for SVHA's 2 supported housing schemes in Manchester and Blackburn. The outcome of the tender process will be a single contract with 1 service provider. The contract will be an initial 2 years with 4 additional options to extend by a further 2 years (24 months), up to a maximum 10 years total contract term, subject to SVHA requirements and performance of the successful service provider. The anticipated contract award date is estimated to be during November 2016. Between 5 and 8 bidders are expected to be shortlisted and invited to tender following the PQQ short-listing stage.

Main site or place of performance: Services initially required are in Manchester and Blackburn but may also be used where SVHA has an operational requirement. SVHA reserves the right to add or remove sites during the contract.

II.2.4. Description of the procurement

The client is seeking bids from service providers to provide a concierge and guarding service for SVHA's 2 supported housing schemes in Manchester and Blackburn. Services initially required under the contract are expected to include 24 hour, 365 days a year guarding at the Blackburn foyer and night guarding (20:00-8:00), 365 days a year at the Manchester foyer. Security officers must have the ability to work across multiple sites and respond quickly in the event of an emergency (i.e. absence). The sites cannot be left unattended at any time. SVHA reserve the right to request the removal of individuals from the schemes at short notice if it is suspected that they have breach the standards required.

Interviews will be conducted as part of the Invitation to Tender stage.

Estimated annual value is 130 000 GBP ex. VAT based upon historical expenditure however this is an estimate only. The estimated total value is for information only, and no guarantees are given, nor are implied as to the value of business that will be placed with the successful service provider. SVHA reserves the right to add or remove sites or otherwise change the volume of work during the life of the contract.

The contract will be available to SVHA and all subsidiaries both current and future.

Any contract awarded as a result of this competition will be subject to 6 months' notice of termination by either party, throughout the contract period.
