QA Standards: BS EN ISO 9001:2008 with 3rd Party Certification accredited/recognised by UKAS, with an appropriate scope to meet the requirement. In the event that no ISO certification is held, the Company must be able to demonstrate that they operate and maintain a business/quality management system acceptable to the Department within that same scope. Expressions of interest received after the deadline will not be considered. The decision of the Authority is final.

After the expression of interest deadline has passed a Pre Qualification Questionnaire (PQQ) may be issued to assist with the down-selection process. Post down-select process an Invitation to Tender (ITT) may be issued to select companies. Tenders will be assessed to establish which is the lowest priced complaint bid.
