Bergen, Modalen, Osterøy and Øygarden Municipalities, as well as Bergen Church Council and Betanien rehabilitation and nursing home would like to enter into a new framework agreement with one tenderer for the procurement and delivery of wood and building materials, as well as logically associated products. The procurement is for the procurement and delivery of wood and construction materials for ongoing internal and external maintenance of the contracting authority's existing buildings at each user place. The contract will mainly be used by the municipality's internal trade services.

The contracting authority requires that the tenderer, possibly sub-suppliers, have a sales outlet and stores in Bergen municipality during the contract period.

The deliveries do not include the delivery of products where trade companies/contractors are engaged and where the delivery of materials is included as a part of the assignment.
