The core task of the contractor would be to ensure that a high-quality and sufficient coverage dataset on the state of play of the infrastructure of the respective modes would be available in the TENtec database. Lot 1 regards the collection and encoding of data related to the railway infrastructure, rail connectivity of airports and selected parameters for road infrastructure. Lot 2 concerns data parameters for inland waterways infrastructure. The aim is to use the data stored in the TENtec system in particular for monitoring the evolution of the transport networks and their core parameters, identifying missing links and bottlenecks and the main infrastructure projects in the pipeline. It also provides for necessary transparency to stakeholders and market participants.
