Protected Mobility Team (PMT), as part of the UK Ministry of Defence (MoD), intends to issue an Invitation to Tender for Post Design Services (PDS) for the HUSKY Vehicle. The vehicles were previously procured under Contract SUVC1/0207 from Navistar Defense LLC, who has exclusive rights to the IPR. MOD does not hold rights to this IPR, and as the IP holder has stated that they are not prepared to release their proprietary IP to a third party, it is therefore impracticable for MOD to identify a lawful equivalent source of Post Design Services. For this reason it is considered that this ITT can be issued using the negotiated procedure without notice pursuant to Article 28(1)(e) of Directive 2009/81/EC (Regulation 16(1)(a)(ii) of the UK Public Contracts Regulations 2006.
