The aim of this contract is to provide the medical department of the European Commission in Brussels with individual service providers or groupings of individual service providers, clinics, medical practices or consortia of medical specialists in the field of general medicine.

On the basis of an annual estimate, the total volume of services to be provided under this contract is 4 950 hours/year.

To cover the total volume of services, the European Commission shall award 6 contracts of 825 hours/year, i.e. 20 hours/week.

Contracts will be awarded as follows:

- the lowest-priced tender will be awarded the first contract for the services corresponding to the tender submitted (825 hours/year),
- the second lowest-priced tender will be awarded the second contract for the services corresponding to the tender submitted (825 hours/year),
- the third lowest-priced tender will be awarded the third contract for the services corresponding to the tender submitted (825 hours/year),
- the fourth lowest-priced tender will be awarded the fourth contract for the services corresponding to the tender submitted (825 hours/year),
- the fifth lowest-priced tender will be awarded the fifth contract for the services corresponding to the tender submitted (825 hours/year),
- the sixth lowest-priced tender will be awarded the sixth contract for the services corresponding to the tender submitted (825 hours/year),
- a natural person may only submit a tender for 825 hours/year.

Groupings of individual service providers, clinics, medical practices or consortia of service providers are permitted to submit their tender for 1 or several volumes provided that each of the proposed service providers does not exceed 825 hours of services per year. In their tender the latter shall identify the number of volumes desired and include the same number of CVs and required documentation, the contents of which are listed in Article 5 of the specifications 'Selection criteria — Technical capacity', as the number of volumes required.

The distribution of services will be based on the price, on the provider's agenda and the language profile required.

In the event of several tenders having the same lowest price, the tenderers concerned will be asked to submit new prices to settle the tie.

If the lowest-priced tender was submitted by a grouping authorised to tender for the 6 volumes

of 825 hours/year, this grouping will be considered as the sole successful tenderer for the contract.

However, this information is given as a guideline only and is not in any way binding on the European Commission as regards the volume of work.

In accordance with Article 126(1)(f) and (3) of Commission Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 2342 /2002 of 23.12.2002, as amended by Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 1261/2005 of 20.7.2005 laying down the detailed rules for implementation, contracting authorities may use the negotiated procedure to award contracts involving the repetition of similar services entrusted to the economic operator awarded the initial contract. This procedure can only be applied during a period of 3 years following conclusion of the initial contract.
