Qualification requirement: the tenderers must have experience from similar services. Similar services are in this context defined as laboratory tests for textiles and consultancy services to independent third parties not related to the laboratory.

Documentation requirement: an overview of the tenderer's 3 most relevant assignments in the last 3 years. In order to ensure sufficient competition, documentation of deliveries that the tenderer carried out more than three three years ago can also be taken into consideration. The overview must include an indication of each assignment's value, date, recipient (name, telephone number and e-mail address) and a general description of the contract. The tenderer must complete annex 6; references. It is the tenderer's responsibility to confirm relevance through the description.

Qualification requirement: the tenderer must be accredited in accordance with ISO 17025 or equivalent.

Documentation: certificates or other documentation that verify the compliance with the requirement.

Qualification requirement: the tenderer shall have a good environmental management system.

Documentation requirement: a description of the environmental management measures that have been implemented in the company. If the tenderer is certified in accordance with ISO 14001 or equivalent standards, it is sufficient to present a copy of a valid certificate.
