The contracting authority hereby invites tenderers to an open tender contest for a contract for the hire and laundering of workwear and institutional clothing for the health and care service. The Contracting Authority requires a service that includes hiring and laundering work clothes and institution textiles for the health and welfare service. The service also includes collecting and delivering the textiles 1 time per week to Vikhammer helsetun and Hommelvik helsetun in Malvik Municipality.

The laundered textiles will mainly be workwear and institutional textiles. Institutional textiles means duvet covers, pillowcases, sheets, draw sheets, fitted sheets, dishcloths, towels, blankets, etc. (the list is not exhaustive).

Work clothes for the health institutions is typical workwear for the branch, consisting of trousers, lab coats, etc. The workwear for the institutions must be suitable for each season, i. e., one suitable for summer use and one suitable for winter use.

This assignment concerns the hire, laundering and distribution of work/institutional clothing and flat textiles for the health and care service.

The contracting authority's description of the delivery follows from the procurement documentation.

The Credit Rating which will form the basis for qualification to this contest shall not be lower than 'Credit Worthy' (equivalent to score A at Bisnode CreditPro, DB).

Minimum level(s) of standards possibly required:

Credit assessment based on the most recent accounting figures. The rating must be carried out by a credit rating company such as Bisnode or an equivalent company with a licence to conduct this service. Not older than 6 months. The minimum credit rating requirement is A or equivalent.

Companies with a lower rating, start-up companies, companies under formation, companies with no activity or companies that have not been credit-rated, parent company guarantees, bank guarantees, etc., can instead be submitted that provide an equivalent security for the execution capacity. The company organisation number shall be provided for the parent company if a parent company guarantee is used.
