The framework agreement period is 2 years, with an exclusive option for the contracting authorities for 1+1 year extension. The agreement has three (3) different start-up dates. See point 1.3. The hazardous waste fractions included in this call for tenders are given in annex 4 price sheet. The list is not complete and new types of hazardous waste may be added during the agreement period. Hazardous bulky waste such as impregnated wood, inert masses and risk waste are not included in this agreement.

Qualification requirements

VI.4.3. Review procedure

Precise information on deadline(s) for review procedures:

§ 25-2. Waiting period before the contract is signed.

1) The contracting authority can enter into a contract after the waiting period has expired at the earliest, this period is determined by the contracting authority. The waiting period shall be at least 10 days calculated from the day after the notification on the chosen tenderer has been sent. If the contracting authority has made an exception from the requirement for using electronic communication, the waiting period shall be a minimum of 15 days.
