If the financial statements or the declaration show an average loss over the past 3 years, the tenderer must provide another document as proof of his financial and economic capacity, such as the appropriate guarantee from a third party (e.g. the parent company), statements from auditors, chartered accountants or equivalent,

— statement as to the average overall annual turnover during the past 3 financial years.

Minimum level(s) of standards possibly required:

to be selected, the tenderer must provide proof of an average overall annual turnover for the past 3 financial years of:

— for lot 1: 300 000 EUR,

— for lot 2: 400 000 EUR,

— for lot 3: not applicable.

NB: in the case of a tender for several lots, the minimum required figure shall equal the total amount resulting from adding together the minimum required for each lot.

III.1.3. Technical and professional ability

for all lots: the lists shall be in tabular form and detail for each vehicle the number and date of registration, make, model, Euro standard complied with, category to which it relates and the number of seats for that category, the main comfort features (air conditioning, toilets, refrigerator, etc.). The list shall be accompanied by a copy of the valid registration certificates.

Minimum level(s) of standards possibly required:

for lot 1: list of 10 registered vehicles in the category comparable to '1, 2 or 3 star' (depending on the subcategory specified in the technical specifications), in accordance with the classification established by the IRU, of small (up to 20 seats inclusive), medium (21–49 seats) or high capacity (50 seats and above) excluding driver, that the tenderer personally holds

either by ownership, hire-purchase agreement, rental or leasing. At least 5 of the 10 vehicles shall comply with the Euro 5 standard and the others with the Euro 4 standard as a minimum;

for lot 2: list of 10 registered vehicles in the category comparable to '3 star' in accordance with the classification established by the IRU, with at least 50 seats, that the tenderer personally holds either by ownership, hire-purchase agreement, rental or leasing. At least 5 of the 10 vehicles shall comply with the Euro 5 standard and the others with the Euro 4 standard as a minimum;

for lot 3: list of at least 2 registered vehicles in the category comparable to '4 star — luxury — VIP' in accordance with the classification established by the IRU, corresponding to the Euro 5 standard, as a minimum, with a total maximum capacity of at least 90 seats, that the tenderer personally holds either by ownership, hire-purchase agreement, rental or leasing.

NB: in the case of a tender for several lots, the minimum required figure shall equal the total amount resulting from adding together the minimum required for each lot.
