This is for technical reasons. Rotzler GMBH. + Co.KG, are the original equipment manufacturer of this unique winch system, which has very complex interoperability requirements between the interdependent parts which are essential for the system to work safely as a whole. Only EKA Ltd. as the Rotzler sole appointed agent for this TR2000 winch system, have access to the confidential information, technical knowledge and know how to fulfil this requirement. In addition, without their assurance that every part of the system has been maintained to the correct standard then operational integrity, operator safety & equipment effectiveness will be compromised.
