This includes, among other things, requirements for: • Emission free construction site • Transport of emission free vehicles or vehicles on biogas. • Passive house for new buildings, as well as specific requirements for energy reduction for rehabilitated Buildings • Re-use of building materials Furthermore there are separate requirements for building waste minimisation, plastic reduction and reduction of mass transport in the environmental follow-up plan. From the requirement specification with annexes it is stated that areas are planned in an area efficient manner that is adapted to the contracting authority's needs. The total requirements are aimed directly at emissions and resource use in the implementation, and therefore provide greater and more secure climate and environmental effect than using the environment as the award criteria. The Public Procurement Regulations § 7-9 (4) will therefore be used. Although the exception in the procurement regulations § 7-9 (4) applies, the contracting authority has nevertheless chosen to set up an environment as the award criteria in this procurement. This is done in order to achieve further reductions of environmental and climate impact within what has been identified and assessed as suitable themes, see the award criteria below.
