Main features of the procedure: The framework agreement is for machine contractor services and ground work, operation and maintenance of roads/streets/paths for the Norwegian Armed Forces' locations in Østfold/Frogn. Machine contractor services must also be performed in nearby municipalities, such as Halden, Fredrikstad (Including Rauøy), Råde, Moss and Frogn municipalities. Estimated value: NOK 250 million excluding VAT. Maximum value: NOK 312 million excluding VAT. Winter maintenance is carried out as separate contracts and is not included in this framework agreement. The work in the summer typically consists of sweeping /brushing, binding dust, watering, thicket crushing, trench cleaning, maintenance of sub-drains and culverts, stirring and planing of gravel cover roads. Ground and excavation works, as well as patching of asphalt must also be expected. Typical assignments that experience wise will make up the lion's share of the call-offs are: Road maintenance, including planing, gravel and repairs of gravel roads, asphalt patching, edge turning, trench cleaning, dust binding and gutter repairs.
