The works consist mainly of designing and refurbishing existing footpaths, refurbishing whinstone footpaths and forming new whinstone footpaths, approximate areas as detailed in bill of quantities.

This work will require the use of some heavy machinery (2.5 Tonne rollers, jcb's dumpers, etc.) Other works include the creation of removal and landscaping type 1 paths, construction of type I and Bitmac paths, drainage ditches, pipe culverts, upgrading and repair of bridges, removal of stock fencing and construction of stock proof fencing, and general tidying up of construction sites.
