II.2.4. Description of the procurement

In Brussels, the European Parliament currently occupies a building stock of 18 buildings with a total area of about 700 000 m². In addition to parliamentarians and regular staff, the institution hosts external service providers and visitors.

The public in the buildings can be up to about 12 000 people per day.

The contract covers the following fields:

— field 1: fire safety of people and property, pursuant to the regulations governing fire and panic hazards, and assistance to people, including the fire safety control centre. The hourly volume is estimated at ± 84 700/year,

— field 2: permanent and continuous external surveillance, by static surveillance services and /or mobile surveillance services (in accordance with article 2 of the law of 2.10.2017 regulating private and personal security — the so-called "Jambon" Law) by predefined rounds (in particular in the perimeter called Vigilis) including the reporting of any anomalies encountered, the inspection of locks of all the external exits of the buildings, and registration with the round control equipment in the planned order, as well as static services at predefined checkpoints.

The hourly volume is estimated at ± 60 000/year.
