The Avon and Somerset Constabulary (Authority) intends to invite tenders for the provision of a vehicle body shop repairer to provide services in support of its 1 000 plus fleet of police vehicles. For the purpose of the contract the fleet has been divided into 4 vehicle groups.

Group A - Cars, car-derived vans, four wheel drives and people carriers

Group B - Medium panel vans and minibuses (up to 3 500kg GVW)

Group C - Large panel vans and minibuses (3 501 to 7 500kg GVW)

Group D - LGV (over 7 500kg GVW and specialist vehicles)

The contract will be for a vehicle body shop repair service and the Authority is looking to appoint 1 or more repairers to cover the Avon and Somerset Constabulary force area. The Authority would ideally like the same supplier to provide the service for the whole force area, however, if you are limited to a geographical area please still submit an expression of interest.

Precise information on deadline(s) for review procedures: This authority will incorporate a minimum 10 day calendar day standstill period at the point information on the award of the contract is communicated to tenderers. This period allows unsuccessful tenderers to seek further debriefing from the contracting authority before the contract is entered into.

Applicants have two working days from notification of the award decision to request additional debriefing and that information has to be provided a minimum of 3 working days before expiry of the standstill period. Such additional information should be requested from the address in section 1.1.

If an appeal regarding the award of a contract has not been successfully resolved the Public Contracts Regulations 2006 (SI 2006 no 5) provide for aggrieved parties who have been harmed or are at risk of harm by a breach of the rules to take action in the High Court (England, Wales and Northern Ireland). Any such action must be brought promptly (generally within three months). Where a contract has not been entered into the court may order the settling aside of the award decision or order the authority to amend any document and may award damages. If the contract has been entered into the court may only award damages.
