In the framework of creating a visible in-house security presence, the European Parliament's Directorate of Security intends to recruit approximately 400 security and surveillance staff over the next 3 years for the European Parliament's sites in Brussels, Luxembourg and Strasbourg, who will receive common basic training which takes account of the institution's particular characteristics. In addition to the basic training, the Parliament would also like each staff member to attend an annual refresher course in each of the fields covered. These training and refresher courses will be given in English and/or French.
